TLO ANNOUNCES CHANGES IN PROTOCOLS FOR WORSHIP BEGINNING MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND:

1. Hymnals and Bibles are returned to the sanctuary.

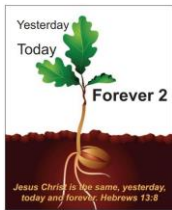

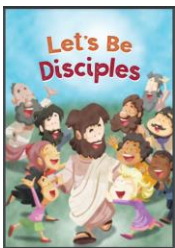
