## Moses is our Model

✓ **Faith sees God’s \_\_\_\_\_ of us.**

“Moses regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.” ((Hebrews 11:26)

“Moses chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time.” (Hebrews 11:25)

✓ **Faith sees God’s \_\_\_\_\_ us.**

“By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king’s anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible.” (Hebrews 11:27)

✓ **Faith sees God’s \_\_\_\_\_ us.**

“By faith Moses kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, so that the destroyer of the firstborn would not touch the firstborn of Israel.” (Hebrews 11:28)

✓ **Faith sees God’s \_\_\_\_\_ us.**

“By faith the people passed through the Red Sea as on dry land; but when the Egyptians tried to do so, they were drowned.” ((Hebrews 11:29)
